

1. ΟΝΟΜΑΣΙΑ ΤΟΥ ΦΑΡΜΑΚΕΥΤΙΚΟΥ ΠΡΟΪΟΝΤΟΣ

DIFICLIR 200 mg επικαλυμμένα με λεπτό υμένιο δισκία

2. ΠΟΙΟΤΙΚΗ ΚΑΙ ΠΟΣΟΤΙΚΗ ΣΥΝΘΕΣΗ

Κάθε δισκίο περιέχει 200 mg fidaxomicin. Για τον πλήρη κατάλογο των εκδόσων, βλ. παράγραφο 6.1.

3. ΦΑΡΜΑΚΟΤΕΧΝΙΚΗ ΜΟΡΦΗ

Επικαλυμμένο με λεπτό υμένιο δισκίο. Δισκία σχήματος καρδίου, χρώματος λευκού έως υπόλευκου, με τυπωμένο το «FD» στη μία πλευρά και «200» στην άλλη πλευρά.

4. ΚΛΙΝΙΚΕΣ ΠΛΗΡΟΦΟΡΙΕΣ

4.1 Θεραπευτικές ενδείξεις: Το DIFICLIR ενδείκνυται σε ενήλικες για τη θεραπεία των λοιμώξεων του *Clostridium difficile* (CD), επίσης γνωστή ως διάρροια συσχετιζόμενη με το *C. difficile* (CDAD) (βλέπε παράγραφο 5.1). Θα πρέπει να λαμβάνονται υπόψη οι επίσημες οδηγίες για την κατάλληλη χρήση των αντιβιοτικών παραγόντων.

Δοσολογία: Βλέπετε τα παραρτήματα 2-65 στην:

Η συνιστώμενη δόση είναι 200 mg (ένα δισκίο) δύο φορές ημερησίως (μία φορά κάθε 12 ώρες) για 10 ημέρες.

Παιδιατρικές πληροφορίες: Η ασφάλεια και η αποτελεσματικότητα της fidaxomicin σε παιδιά ηλικίας κάτω των 18 ετών δεν έχει ακόμη εδραιωθεί. Δεν υπάρχουν διαθέσιμα δεδομένα.

Παιρική δυσλειτουργία: Δεν θεωρείται απαραίτητη η προσαρμογή της δόσης. Λόγω των περιορισμένων κλινικών δεδομένων σε αυτόν τον πληθυσμό, το DIFICLIR πρέπει να χρησιμοποιείται με προσοχή σε ασθενείς με σοβαρή δυσλειτουργία (βλέπε παραγράφους 4.4 και 5.2).

Ηπατική δυσλειτουργία: Δεν θεωρείται απαραίτητη η προσαρμογή της δόσης. Λόγω των περιορισμένων κλινικών δεδομένων σε αυτόν τον πληθυσμό, το DIFICLIR πρέπει να χρη-

σιμοποιείται με προσοχή σε ασθενείς με μέτρια έως σοβαρή ηπατική δυσλειτουργία (βλέπε παραγράφους 4.4 και 5.2).

Τρόπος χορήγησης: Το DIFICLIR προορίζεται για χορήγηση από το στόμα. Το DIFICLIR μπορεί να ληφθεί με ή χωρίς τροφή. **4.3 Αντενδείξεις:** Υπερευαίσθησία στη δραστική ουσία ή σε κάποιο από τα έκδοχα που αναφέρονται στην παράγραφο 6.1. **4.4 Ειδικές προειδοποιήσεις και προφυλάξεις κατά τη χρήση:** Έχουν αναφερθεί αντιδράσεις υπερευαίσθησίας συμπεριλαμβανομένου του σοβαρού αγγειοοίδηματος. Εάν παρατηρηθεί μια σοβαρή αλλεργική αντίδραση κατά τη διάρκεια της θεραπείας με το Dificlir, το φαρμακευτικό προϊόν πρέπει να διακοπεί και να λαμβάνονται τα κατάλληλα μέτρα. Μερικοί ασθενείς με αντιδράσεις υπερευαίσθησίας ανέφεραν ιστορικό αλλεργίας σε μακρολίδες. Η fidaxomicin πρέπει να χρησιμοποιείται με προσοχή σε ασθενείς με γνωστή αλλεργία στις μακρολίδες. Λόγω των περιορισμένων κλινικών δεδομένων, η fidaxomicin πρέπει να χρησιμοποιείται με προσοχή σε ασθενείς με σοβαρή νεφρική δυσλειτουργία ή μέτρια έως σοβαρή ηπατική δυσλειτουργία (βλέπε παράγραφο 5.2). Λόγω των περιορισμένων κλινικών δεδομένων, η fidaxomicin πρέπει να χρησιμοποιείται με προσοχή σε ασθενείς με ψευδομεμβρανώδη κολίτιδα, κεραυνοβόλο ή απεπτική για τη ζωή CD. Δεν υπάρχουν στοιχεία σε ασθενείς με συνοδό φλεγμονώδη νόσο του ατέρους. Η fidaxomicin πρέπει να χρησιμοποιείται με προσοχή σε αυτούς τους ασθενείς λόγω του κινδύνου της αυξημένης απορρόφησης και του πιθανού κίνδυνου συμπτωμάτων ανεπιθύμητων αντιδράσεων. Η συγχρησιμοποίηση ορισμένων ανιστολαμίνης P-βλακωρικών όπως κλοξισολίνη, κετακιμολίνη, ερυθρομυκίνη, κλαριθρομυκίνη, βεραπρίλη, βρομεπρόλη και ριμωδαρόνη δεν συνιστάται (βλέπε παραγράφους 4.5 και 5.2).

Προσοχή στη πληθυσμιακή ασφάλεια σε κλινικές δοκιμές. Στις δύο κλινικές δοκιμές ασθενών με CD, το 47,9% (479/999) των ασθενών (συμπεριλαμβανομένου του πληθυσμού του προποικισμού) ήταν ηλικίας ≥ 65 ετών και το 27,5% (275/999) των ασθενών υποβλήθηκε σε ταυτόχρονη θεραπεία με αντιβιοτικά κατά τη διάρκεια της περιόδου της μελέτης. Το αντίστοιχο ποσοστό εκεί των ασθενών εκπλήρωσε ταυτόχρονα ένα από τα ακόλουθα τρία κριτήρια στη τιμή αναφοράς σε ότι αφορούσε τη σοβαρότητα της

διαβόησης: θερμοκρασία σώματος > 38,5°C, αριθμός λευκοκυττάρων > 15.000 ή τιμή κρεατινίνης ≥ 1,5 mg/dl. Οι ασθενείς με κεραυνοβόλο κολίτιδα και οι ασθενείς με πολλαπλά επεισόδια (ορίζονται ως περισσότερα του ενός προηγούμενα επεισόδια εντός των προηγούμενων 3 μηνών) CD αποκλείστηκαν από τις μελέτες. **4.8 Ανεπιθύμητες ενέργειες:** Περίληψη του προφίλ ασφαλείας Το προφίλ ασφαλείας του DIFICLIR βασίζεται σε δεδομένα από 564 ασθενείς με CD στους οποίους χορηγήθηκε θεραπεία με fidaxomicin σε μελέτες Φάσης 3. Οι πιο συχνές σχετιζόμενες με τη θεραπεία ανεπιθύμητες ενέργειες ήταν έμετος (1,2%), ναυτία (2,7%) και δυσκοιλιότητα (1,2%). Παρακάτω αναφέρονται οι ανεπιθύμητες ενέργειες που σχετίζονται με τη δισ ημερήσια χορήγηση της fidaxomicin στη θεραπεία της λοίμωξης από *C. difficile* που αναφέρθηκαν σε τουλάχιστον δύο ασθενείς, παρουσιάζονται ανά κατηγορία οργανικού συστήματος. Η συχνότητα των ανεπιθύμητων ενεργειών ορίζεται ως εξής: πολύ συχνές (≥1/10), συχνές (≥1/100 έως <1/10), όχι συχνές (≥1/1.000 έως <1/100), σπάνιες (≥1/10.000 έως <1/1.000), πολύ σπάνιες (<1/10.000), μη γνωστές (δεν υπάρχουν να εκτιμηθούν με βάση τα διαθέσιμα δεδομένα). Εντός κάθε κατηγορίας συστήματος εμμένουν οι ανεπιθύμητες ενέργειες παρατηρηθείσα κατά φθίνουσα σειρά σοβαρότητας. **Κατηγορία/Οργανικό Σύστημα κατά MedDRA**

Διαταραχές του ανοσοποιητικού συστήματος - Όχι συχνές: εξάνθημα, κνημίδες - Συχνότητα μη γνωστή: αντιδράσεις υπερευαίσθησίας (αγγειοοίδημα, δύσπνοια), διαταραχές του μεταβολισμού και θρέψης - Όχι συχνές: μειωμένη όρεξη. Διαταραχές του νευρικού συστήματος - Όχι συχνές (όχι κεφαλαλγία, δύσπνοια). Διαταραχές του γαστρεντερικού - Συχνές έμετος (από δυσκοιλιότητα). Όχι συχνές: κολική διάταση, μεταμεταβολική εφροσύνη, διαταραχές του ήπατος - Όχι συχνές: αυξημένη εμπατισσαρόφιλη της αλανίνης. Διαταραχές του αναπνευστικού συστήματος - Ανεπιθύμητες ενέργειες. Η αναφορά πιθανολογούμενων ανεπιθύμητων ενεργειών μετά από τη χορήγηση άδειας κυκλοφορίας του φαρμακευτικού προϊόντος είναι σημαντική. Επιτρέπει τη διεύρεση παρακολούθηση της σχέσης οφελούς-κινδύνου του φαρμακευτικού προϊόντος. Ζητείται από τους επαγγελματίες του τομέα της υγειονομικής περίθαλξης να αναφέρουν
