

Dr Haralampos Milionis was born in 1968 in Ioannina, Greece. Currently, he serves as Professor of Internal Medicine at the School of Medicine of the University of Ioannina, Greece. He graduated from the homonymous School of Medicine in 1991 and received his PhD in 1999.

His research studies and training were reinforced during his sabbaticals in the Department of Molecular Biology and Clinical Biochemistry in the Royal Free Hospital, UCL, London, UK in 1999 and in the Cerebrovascular Unit of the Centre Hospitalier Universitaire Vaudois, Lausanne, Switzerland in 2011.

He is the Academic Head and Director of the 1st Division of Internal Medicine and the Unit of Infectious Diseases of the University Hospital of Ioannina as well as the Research Laboratory of the Department of Internal Medicine, School of Medicine, University of Ioannina. He serves as a Consultant in the Outpatient Lipid Clinic and runs the Outpatient Unit for Cardiovascular Risk Factor Modification for Children and Adolescents of the University Hospital of Ioannina. He is a Faculty member of the Atherothrombosis Research Centre of the University of Ioannina.

Dr Milionis is an active member of the Hellenic and the European Atherosclerosis Societies and a fellow of the Hellenic and the European Stroke Organizations.

He is an active member of the Hellenic (HAS) and European Society of Atherosclerosis (EAS) and a Fellow of the Hellenic Atherosclerosis (HSO) and the European Stroke Organization (ESO). He is a member of the ESO Membership Committee and a member of the editorial team of the ESO Guidelines for the Secondary Prevention of Stroke of Non-Cardioembolic Etiology.

His research field focuses in the pathophysiology of atherothrombosis, the clinical and epidemiological study of risk factors for cardiovascular disease and the secondary prevention of stroke and stroke prognosis. He has been participating in several observational clinical studies and randomized clinical trials. He has authored and co-authored more than 320 peer-reviewed publications (ISI citations >7000; h factor 45) and has been serving as a reviewer and a member of the Editorial Board of national and international journals.
